FESTIVAL PLESKAVICA 2010

Festival Pleskavica 2010 sestavljata dva sklopa: **Kratki rezi 3**, kjer se predstavlja 14 sodobnoplesnih premier udeležencev letošnje mednarodne nomadske plesne akademije **NOMAD Dance Academy (NDA)**, in drugi del **Povečava**, kjer bodo predstavljene tri sodobnoplesne predstave avtorjev in plesalcev, ki jih v tem prostoru tako ali drugače že poznamo. Z diskusijami o plesnih potencialih regije in načinih sodelovanj, pa bomo skupaj s partnerji NDA odprli vprašanja o tem, kako lahko sodobni ples naše regije ponudi evropski plesni pulziji specifično umetniško razliko.

The upcoming Pleskavica Festival 2010 consists of two main and somewhat distinct programmes. The first is entitled Short Cuts 3 and will premiere 14 short contemporary dance performances created by participants of this year's NOMAD Dance Academy (NDA), whereas the second entitled Blow Up will present three contemporary dance performances of authors and dancers already familiar to the local audience. The festival programme will be accompanied by discussions on the subject of the Region's dance potentials and possible models of collaboration together with the meetings of the NDA partners. These events are planned for the purpose of questioning the capabilities and the specificities of the regional productions and their placement into the European context.

KRATKI REZI 3 SHORT CUTS 3

Kratki rezi 3 so premiere sodobnoplesne uprizoritve, ki sledijo idejam štirinajstih potujočih koreografov in plesalcev iz petih južnoslovenskih držav ali držav t. i. Zahodnega Balkana (Slovenija, Hrvaška, Srbija, Makedonija ter Bolgarija) in ostalih držav (Švica, Nemčija in Izrael), ki so v obdobju od 13. marca do 22. junija 2010 živeli, potovali in ustvarjali skupaj v programu **NOMAD Dance Academy**. Ustvarjalci so se vsakih štirinajst dni preselili v drugo državo, v drugo mesto (Skopje, Sofija, Kanjiža, Beograd, Zagreb, Ptuj in Ljubljana), ki jim je nudilo umetniško rezidenco z delavnicami, predavanji, soočenja z lokalnimi in mednarodnimi umetniki in teoretiki kot tudi prostor za lastno umetniško raziskovanje.

Nomadi bodo s pomočjo umetniških svetovalcev in lokalne tehnične ekipe v Ljubljani v zelo kratkem času ustvarili niz kratkih zgodb, situacij in dogodkov (5 – 30 minut) in jih izvedli na različnih lokacijah. Svetlobo, ton, sceno in video v Kratkih rezih 3 bodo soustvarjali mladi slovenski odrski tehniki, ki se izobražujejo v zdaj že tradicionalni Bunkerjevi tehnični delavnici.

Short Cuts 3 / Kratki rezi3 consist of contemporary dance premiere performances, arising on the basis of ideas by fourteen travelling choreographers and dancers coming from five Southern-Slavic countries or, to be more specific, from the countries belonging to the so called Western Balkans region (Slovenia, Croatia, Serbia, Macedonia and Bulgaria) and from other countries (Switzerland, Germany, Israel), who have been sharing a mutual living, travelling and artistic reality in the period between 13th March and June 2010 in the framework of the NOMAD Dance Academy. The nomadic group of artists has been working in a fluid spirit of moving to another country and another town every two weeks (Skopje, Sofia, Kanjiža, Belgrade, Zagreb, Ptuj and Ljubljana), where their residential stay provided space for their own artistic exploration and was furthermore accompanied by workshops, lectures, new acquaintances with local and international artists and theoreticians.

Thanks to the help of artistic mentors and a local technical team, the Nomads are to create a series of short stories, situations and events (5-30 minutes) and to perform them in different locations. Lighting, sound and video presented will come out of the hands of young Slovene stage technicians, involved in the Bunker technical workshops.

"5 of 50" Passing Through Ljubljana

V prvih treh mesecih letošnjega leta se je 50 profesionalnih plesalcev iz 29. držav zbralo na Kostariki. 10 tednov so bili del edinstvenega projekta 50 days of Flying Low and Passing Through pod vodstvom priznanega pedagoga in koreografa Davida Zambrana, ki je tudi razvil ti dve plesni tehniki. Skupina plesalcev, ki so bili na Kostariki, se je odločila za nadaljevanje in ustvarila plesni projekt, ki nadaljuje z improvizacijsko tehniko Passing Through pod imenom "5 od 50" po različnih mestih sveta. Kot projekt "5 of 50" so se pojavili že v Havani, Amsterdamu in Barceloni. Tokrat se predstavljajo v Ljubljani. ▶▶ *50 professional dancers from 29 countries gathered in Costa Rica during the first three months of this year. They took part in a unique project entitled "50 days of Flying Low and Passing Through" which lasted for 10 weeks and took place under the guidance of a renowned pedagogue and choreographer David Zambrano, who himself also developed the dancing techniques. The group of dancers involved in the Costa Rican project decided to take things further and thus created a dance project entitled "5 of 50" as a further elaboration of a Passing Through improvisation technique, which already saw the light of day in different cities across the globe. The project "5 of 50" was already presented in Havana, Amsterdam and Barcelona. It is Ljubljana's turn this time.*

Ivo Dimchev (BOL) Som Faves

Obstaja seznam stotih tem (pojmov, predmetov ali ljudi), do katerih Dimchev čuti neki odnos navezanosti. Predstava je zasnovana na najljubših Dimchevih temah iz tega seznama. V prostoru muzejske beline in oborožen z lasuljo ter klaviaturo nam Dimchev predstavi na videz neurejeno zbirko tem, ki pa se kljub vsemu počasi sestavijo v intimni portret in tragikomični prikaz različnih pristopov k formi in vsebini znotraj konteksta sodobnega plesa/gledališča. ▶▶ *There is a list of 100 topics (subjects, objects or people) Dimchev feels related to in this or another way. The performance is based on some favourite ones from The List. In space, white as a museum, armed with a wig and keyboard, Dimchev presents us with a seemingly incoherent collection of topics, which nevertheless gradually build up an intimate portrait and a tragic-comic demonstration of various different ways of dealing with form and content within the context of contemporary dance / theatre.*

Sebastijan Horvat (SLO) Utopija

Gledališki projekt Utopija se spopada z razmerjem med publiko in predstavo. Na novo misliti to brezno, bariero, zid – kot ljubezenski odnos, enakopravo partnerstvo ali romantični dvoboj. Predstava ne skuša s privilegiranega piedestala učiti gledalca, ampak se mu skuša odpreti v vsej svoji ranljivosti in neposrednosti, da vstopi vanjo. Utopija je povabilo k potovanju v šestdeseta leta, ko je umetnost še verjela v nemogoče – v razna utopična razmerja med posamezniki, ki težijo v idealno skupnost, ki nenedoma vznikne tukaj in zdaj. Utopija: realnost spremeniti in pritegniti k predstavi. ▶▶ *Theatre project Utopia tackles the relationship arising between an audience on the one hand and a performance on the other. It sets to revisit this abyss, this barrier, this wall – as a love relation, as an equal partnership or as a romantic duel. The performance has no intention of lecturing the spectator from the position of a privileged pedestal, but attempts to open up to him with an invitation to enter, revealing its vulnerable and direct nature. Utopia is an invitation card for a journey into the Sixties, when art still believed in the impossible, namely in various utopian relations between individuals pushing towards their ideal community, which suddenly emerges here and now. Utopia: to change the reality and to introduce it in-to the performance.*

Interstices – Pierre ▶▶ Yves Diacon (CH) OCCUPATION OF EMPTY GAPS / ZASEDANJE PRAZNIH VRZELI

Interstices/Vrzeli uporablja majhne časovne špranje, ki se porajajo med predstavami, in sicer z namenom, da ponovno artikulira ponikajoče delce spomina in odmeve predstav ter obenem na njihovi lokaciji pusti drugačne vrste sledi. Ta koncept si izposoja tematiko nekega drugega projekta, imenovanega "empty shell/ prazna školjka" (www.protopae/pyd_nda_2010), ki je bil sicer zasnovan med NDA 2010, vendar v festivalskem sklopu Kratkih rezov ne bo realiziran. Projekt "empty shell/ prazna školjka" se ozira na začasno osamo prostora, na to, kar je ostalo po nedavno končanem dogodku, za sledovi, ki jih bo pravkar prekrilo ali prepisalo novo dogajanje ter za usedlinami spomina, ki se v plasteh nabirajo v nekem prostoru. ▶▶ *"Interstrices / Vrzeli" is using the small gaps existing in between performances in order to replay extinguishing fragments of memory and resonance from these performances, and as well to leave, around the venues, other type of traces. This proposal borrows the thematic from another performance project, named "empty shell" (www.protopae/pyd_nda_2010), which was elaborated during NDA 2010, but which couldn't be realized for the Short Cut festival. The "empty shell" project seeks for the temporal state of desertion of a place: the remains left behind by an event that had just happened; remains which are about to be covered or overwritten by a new happening; the sedimentary layers of memory accumulated in a place.*
